

FCC COMPLIANCE

On July 28, 2026, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) issued a news release titled ***FCC Updates Covered List to Include Foreign-Produced Advanced Robotic Devices and Power Inverters***, announcing updated regulations governing the authorization of certain communications equipment, including communications devices incorporated into solar inverters. Under these

regulations, affected equipment must comply with the FCC’s equipment authorization requirements before it may be imported, marketed, or placed into service in the United States. The information below summarizes Yaskawa Solectria Solar’s compliance with these requirements and provides the applicable FCC certification details for the SOLECTRIA XGI 1500 inverter product family.
